Race walking: Vacaville grad Robyn Stevens walks away with USATF 35-K championship

VACAVILLE — Robyn Stevens, a Vacaville High graduate, captured the women's 35-kilometer race walk at the USATF Championships at Santee, Feb. 28.

In the process, Stevens, 37, broke three of her Master 35-39 records. She covered 25 kilometers in 2 hours, 4 minutes, 35 seconds (her old record was 2:08:32), 30 kilometers in 2:32:54 (2:34.41) and 35 kilometers with her winning time of 3:01:08 (3:01:46).

Stevens won the race, which served as the U.S. trials for the 2021 Pan American Race Walk Cup 35-K events, by 4:12 over runner-up Stephanie Casey.
